



Casper Soccer Club Blades Timbers/Thorns

Blades Timbers and Thorns Open Tryouts/Player placements are Monday, June 21 & Tuesday, June 22, 2021, at 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm. Located at the North Casper Soccer Complex, 1700 East K St.

The players with the birth year of 2007 to 2013 are required to attend the player placement tryouts.

The 2007 (9th grade) to 2003 players will not be attending the player placement tryouts. The coaches will be in touch with the older age group.

- **Please arrive early to check in.** Located at the concession building.
- Check in will be available at 5:15pm
- **All Players** must check in to receive a tryout number.
- Players will be assigned a number, which will be placed on the back of their jersey.
- Players need wear a gray or white shirt for the placement tryouts.
- Dress for soccer – shin guards must be worn.
- Bring a properly inflated soccer ball and water bottle.
- The player will then be directed to the designated field for their age and gender.
- Parents will need to remain some distance away from the designated field area.

Players will need to check in both days. A replacement number for the 2nd night will be available, if needed. Player placement tryouts will begin promptly at 6pm. Again, arrive early to check in.

The immediate field area is closed to parents. Parents are allowed to watch, but at a distance from the designated field area.
