

COVID-19 Best Practices for Parents and Spectators

The Staff of the Casper Fall Classic is here to support you and your team during this tournament. We will be taking precautions to prevent the spread of Covid-19. We will implement the following best practices to promote personal safety during the event. By attending this event, you agree to follow all national, state, local, WSA and CSC guidelines and assume all responsibility of risk in attending the Casper Fall Classic.

Guidance for Players:

- Hand contact between teams is prohibited (pre- or post-game handshakes, high 5's, etc.)
- Both teams will provide a clean(sanitized) game ball to the referee.
- The Fall Classic will not provide hydration stations. Players will bring their own.
- No sharing of drinks, snacks, or equipment.
- Exiting teams should clear the field promptly when the math ends. Do not congregate at the field with your team.
- Entering team will wait for exiting team to completely clear the technical area before approaching and/or placing their items in the area. Players items should be spaced in a way that players do not have to touch or move other player's items to access their own.
- Teams and parents/spectators will be on the same side of the field. The opposing team on the opposite side.
- Do not attend if you are feeling sick.
- Anyone who becomes ill during the event is asked to leave the venue immediately and report all occurrences to the team manager.

Spectators/ Parents:

- Spectators are allowed during the event but need to be limited to Parents and immediate family members.
- Parents, symptom check your child before arriving at the soccer complex.
- Spectators must observe social distancing of 6 ft in the spectator area of the fields. Field markings will be provided as guidelines.
- Teams and parents/spectators will be on the same side of the field. The opposing team on the opposite side.
- Spectators/Parents can not enter the technical area (team box).
- Do not congregate in groups of 6 or more on the sidelines and maintain social distance of 6 ft between households.
- Spectators are encouraged to wear a face covering without holes during the event when 6 ft distance can not be maintained.
- No Pets allowed during the event.
- Anyone who is sick or experiencing symptoms commonly associated with Covid-19 STAY HOME.
- If you are a person of high risk, Do Not Attend.

By registering, attending, and entering the event facilities, all participants, including, but not limited to, coaches, layers, parents, spectators, event staff, vendors, partners, medical staff and administrators agree to follow all national, state, local, WSA and CSC guidelines, and assume all responsibility of risk in attending the Casper Fall Classic. The understanding of the risk and agreeing to not indemnify CSC or its staff and volunteers nor hold them responsible for any sickness or health condition that may result from attending the event.
